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All submissions to *Clinical and Experimental Immunology* in the field of primary immunodeficiency are automatically entered for the **Nalinaj Fernando Memorial Award**. This annual prize of £350 is awarded to the corresponding author of the best research article in this subject area.

This award has been generously donated by the Fernando family in memory of Nalinaj Fernando who died, aged 32, as a result of an extremely rare, genetic immunodeficiency disease called 'Bare Lymphocyte Syndrome', the only adult known to have the condition.
